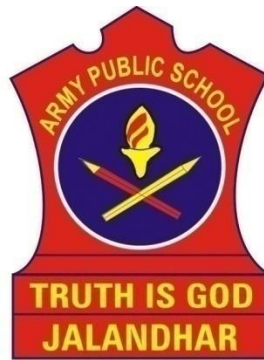

**A. ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE: SCHOLASTIC AREAS**

❖ **SCHEME OF STUDIES:** A candidate is required to study **FOR CLASSES III – V**

- ENGLISH
- HINDI
- MATHEMATICS
- ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES

**FOR CLASSES VI – VIII**

- **LANGUAGE 1:** English
- **LANGUAGE 2:** Hindi
- **OTHER SUBJECTS:** Mathematics, Science, Social Science Computer Science, Punjabi/Sanskrit
- **SKILL SUBJECTS:** Artificial Intelligence, Introduction to financial literacy, Physical activity training, Coding, Handicrafts, Beauty and wellness, Design thinking, Information technology, Marketing/ Commercial application, Mass Media, Travel and Tourism.

## **FOR CLASSES IX-X**

- **LANGUAGE 1:** English
- **LANGUAGE 2:** Hindi
- **OTHER SUBJECTS:** Mathematics, Science, Social Science
- **ADDITIONAL SUBJECTS:** Any LANGUAGE other than language 1 & 2 or Computer Applications
- **SKILL SUBJECTS:** Artificial Intelligence, Introduction to financial literacy, Physical activity training, Coding, Handicrafts, Beauty and wellness, Design thinking, Information technology, Marketing/ Commercial application, Mass Media, Travel and Tourism.

### **❖ ASSESSMENT STRUCTURE:**

- **PEN PAPER TEST-** 20 marks  
For Classes III – X the test to be conducted twice a year including the portion cumulatively.
- **Multiple Assessment** -20 marks  
(Oral test, concept map, quizzes, exit cards, visual expression etc.)
  
- **PORTFOLIO SUBMISSION (20 Marks)**
  - It is based on the following parameters.
  - Class work plus peer assessment
  - Self -assessment
  - Achievements of student in the subject
  - Reflections
  - Narrations
  - Journals etc.
  - To be assessed twice a year for classes III-VIII( Term I & Term II)
  - To be assessed thrice a year for classes IX- X
  
- **SUBJECT ENRICHMENT ACTIVITY (20 Marks)**
  - Listening and Speaking skills for languages, etc
  - Practical work for Science
  - Lab work for Mathematics
  - Map work & Project Work for Social Science.
  - To be assessed twice a year for **Classes III – VIII.**
  - To be assessed thrice a year for **Classes IX – X**

**PEN PAPER TEST, Multiple Assessment, Portfolio and Subject Enrichment each will be converted into 5 Marks.**

- **LANGUAGES**
  - ✓ **ENGLISH:** speaking, listening , reading/ debate
  - ✓ **HINDI :** speaking, listening, reading/debate
  - ✓ **SANSKRIT:** speaking, listening, reading/debate (For Classes VI – VIII)
  - ✓ **PUNJABI:** speaking, listening, reading/debate (For Classes VI – X)
- **ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES:** Activity/Project, Group Discussion, Notebook (For Classes III – V)
- **MATHEMATICS:** lab activity, project/ model making

- **SOCIAL SCIENCE:** map, activity, project/ model making
- **COMPUTER SCIENCE:** practical assessment
- **6<sup>TH</sup> ADDITIONAL SUBJECT**
  - ✓ In case student opts a language as 6<sup>th</sup> additional subject the modalities defined for languages 1 and 2 shall be followed.
- **COMPUTER APPLICATIONS ( For Class IX –X)and ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE( For Class IX)**

**NOTE:**

- The assessment structure and examination for classes III – X comprises of two terms i.e. TERM – 1 and TERM – 2 of 100 marks each.
- Student has to score 33% marks in both Written Exams and Periodic Assessment individually.
- For Classes III – VIII, Internal Assessment to be conducted before the end of each term.
- For Classes IX – X, Internal Assessment to be conducted thrice a year i.e., May, Aug, Dec/Jan

**SCHEME OF EXAMINATION (III – X)**

**1. No Semester System**

- **YEARLY EXAMINATION** will take place at the end of the session covering the percentage of the syllabus as follows:  
Class III - VIII: entire syllabus of SECOND TERM and important topic of Term-I.
  - FOR CLASSES III-VI : 10% syllabus of TERM-I
  - FOR CLASS VII : 20% syllabus of TERM-I
  - FOR CLASS VIII : 30% syllabus of TERM-I
  - FOR CLASS IX : Entire syllabus for Yearly Exam  
i.e., FIRST TERM + SECOND TERM
- **FINAL RESULT** will comprise the marks of **YEARLY EXAMINATION** (BOARD for class X) will be of 80 marks and **PERIODIC/INTERNAL ASSESSMENT** will be of 20 marks.
- It is mandatory to score 33% marks in each subject.
- Marks and Grades both will be awarded for individual subjects.
- 9 – Point grading will be same as followed by the Board in Class X.

## SCHEME OF EXAMINATION ( XI – XII)

The academic year is divided into four terms. Each term will be followed by an exam. The weightage for each exam for class XI is as follows:

Exam	Class XI
Unit Test – I	10%
Half Yearly Exam	30%
Unit Test – II	10%
Annual Exam	50%

**Note:**

- The final result of class XI will be based on the child’s performance throughout the year.
- A candidate failing in one of the five subjects of the examination shall be placed in compartment in that subject provided he/she qualifies in all other subjects as per rules.
- For practical subject the student has to pass independently in theory and practical to be eligible for promotion to class XII.
- Skilled subjects for Class XI: Mass media, Artificial Intelligence, Web Designing.
