

❖ **ASSESSMENT STRUCTURE:**

- **PEN PAPER TEST-** 40 marks
For Classes VI – IX the test to be conducted twice a year including the portion cumulatively.

Note:

For Class X Pre-Board-I (80 marks) will be conducted in place of Pen Paper–III (40 marks).

- **MULTIPLE ASSESSMENT (25 Marks)**
(Oral test, concept map, quizzes, exit cards, visual expression etc.)
- **PORTFOLIO SUBMISSION (25 Marks)**
 - It is based on the following parameters.
 - Class work plus peer assessment
 - Self –assessment

- Achievements of student in the subject
- Reflections
- Narrations
- Journals etc.
- **SUBJECT ENRICHMENT ACTIVITY (25 Marks)**
 - Listening and Speaking skills for languages, etc
 - Practical work for Science
 - Lab work for Mathematics
 - Map work & Project Work for Social Science.

PEN PAPER TEST+ INTERNAL ASSESSMENT (Multiple Assessment, Portfolio and Subject Enrichment) each will be converted into 5 Marks.

- **LANGUAGES**
 - ✓ **ENGLISH:** speaking, listening , reading/ debate
 - ✓ **HINDI :** speaking, listening, reading/debate
 - ✓ **SANSKRIT:** speaking, listening, reading/debate (For Classes VI – VIII)
 - ✓ **PUNJABI:** speaking, listening, reading/debate (For Classes VI – X)
- **MATHEMATICS:** lab activity, project/ model making
- **SCIENCE:** lab activity, project/ model making
- **SOCIAL SCIENCE:** map, activity, project/ model making
- **COMPUTER SCIENCE:** practical assessment
- **INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY and ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE:** Theory + Practical (For Class IX –X)

NOTE:

- The assessment structure and examination for classes VI – VIII comprises of two terms i.e. TERM – 1 and TERM – 2 of 100 marks each. Internal Assessment to be conducted before the end of each term.
- Student has to score 33% marks in both Written Exams and Periodic Assessment individually.
 - For Classes IX – X, Internal Assessment to be conducted twice a year as per schedule.

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION (VI – X)

- YEARLY EXAMINATION will take place at the end of the session covering the percentage of the syllabus as follows:
Class VI - VIII: entire syllabus of SECOND TERM and important topics of Term-I.
 - FOR CLASS VI : 10% syllabus of TERM
 - FOR CLASS VII : 20% syllabus of TERM-I
 - FOR CLASS VIII : 30% syllabus of TERM-I
 - FOR CLASS IX-X : Entire syllabus for Yearly Exam
- FINAL RESULT will comprise the marks of YEARLY EXAMINATION (BOARD for class X) will be of 80 marks and PERIODIC/INTERNAL ASSESSMENT will be of 20 marks.
- It is mandatory to score 33% marks in each subject.
- Marks and Grades both will be awarded for individual subjects.

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION (XI – XII)

For Class XI academic year is divided into four terms. Each term will be followed by an exam. The weightage for each exam is as follows:

Exam	Class XI
Periodic Test – I	10%
Periodic Test – II /Half Yearly Exam	30%
Periodic Test – III	10%
Annual Exam	50%

Note:

- The final result of class XI will be based on the child's performance throughout the year.
- A candidate failing in one of the five subjects of the examination shall be placed in compartment in that subject provided he/she qualifies in all other subjects as per rules.
- For practical subject the student has to pass independently in theory and practical to be eligible for promotion to class XII.
- Skilled subjects for Class XI: Artificial Intelligence, Financial Marketing
