IN ATTENDANCE: 51 educators from APS Jalandhar and CBSE schools around the city.

PREMISE: The workshop highlighted the need for teachers to be more aware of the issues of Gender Sensitive Pedagogy, Teaching Learning Materials and various issues of youth in relation to gender dysphoria. It underlined the need for educators to be more aware, sensitive, and receptive to the inclusion of children with diverse abilities in schools and the community. To enable the participants to become gender sensitive teachers, the session delved into Gender Sensitive Lesson Planning, avoiding use of gendered language denigrating any gender. Use of teaching methodologies ensuring equal participation of all students regardless of their gender identity was also stressed upon. Gender sensitive lesson plans were prepared by the participating teachers under the guidance of the resource persons.

The workshop proved to be truly insightful and reflective with a new dawn of understanding inculcated in the educators about various genders and their amalgamation in a more tolerant society.
